The picture books use the technology of GIFs to enhance the reading experience for the child, making her look forward to the next page, and then the following one.

The books are available online in five languages -- English, Hindi, Marathi, Tamil and Kannada-- on StoryWeaver, and can be enjoyed on a laptop, desktop, tablet or mobile phone.

***Gappu Can't Dance***, written by Menaka Raman and illustrated by Krishna Chandran A. Nair, is a story about the joy of dancing, even if you have two left feet.

***Shoecat Thoocat***, written by Shalini Srinivasan and illustrated by Aindri Chakraborty, is a fantasy about an alien shoecat who loves to go *thoooo*.

***The Big Book of Boochandis***, written by Pavithra Sankaran, illustrated by Rucha Dhayarkar, and art directed by Somesh Kumar, is an ode to the beloved eponymous bogeypeople of Tamil Nadu.

"We hope children will love reading these stories and watching the characters and scenes come alive," says Bijal Vachharajani, Senior Editor, Pratham Books. "They can dance, jump and run with the adorable Gappu; giggle at naughty Boochandis as they gobble up food (and feet) and prowl about the story; and marvel at the surreal green-glowing tomato patch bewitched by Shoecat."
